

COMPLETE CARE AND CLEANING GUIDELINES

General Maintenance

Vacuum frequently using the proper attachment to avoid pilling fabric.

General Recommendations

When spill occurs treat stains promptly. The longer a stain is on the wool, the more difficult it will be to remove. A professional furniture cleaning service is recommended.

Stain Treatment

Soak up any excess moisture immediately. Before applying cleaners to the soiled area, test a small hidden area first to be sure there is not adverse effects to the color or texture of the fabric.

For oil and water-based stains, use a clean, soft, white cloth to apply water-free dry cleaning solvent. Blot the stain switching to a clean part of cloth each time. This will avoid reapplying the dirt to the area being cleaned. Avoid excess rubbing to prevent discoloration and damage to the material. Let dry, then vacuum.

For insoluble stains us a plastic bag filled with ice to rub the stain until the substance becomes brittle. Use a clean, dull, flat knife to gently remove the substance.
