

COMPLETE CARE AND CLEANING GUIDELINES

Vacuum frequently using the proper attachment to avoid pilling fabric.

General Recommendations

When spill occurs treat stains promptly. The longer a stain is on the textile, the more difficult it will be to remove. A professional furniture cleaning service is recommended.

Stain Treatment

Soak up any excess moisture immediately. Before applying cleaners to the soiled area, test a small hidden area first to be sure there is not adverse effects to the color or texture of the fabric.

Use a clean, soft, white cloth to apply water-free dry cleaning solvent or mild water based cleanser. Blot the stain switching to a clean part of cloth each time. This will avoid reapplying the dirt to the area being cleaned. Avoid excess rubbing to prevent discoloration and damage to the material. Let dry, then vacuum.

For insoluble stains use a plastic bag filled with ice to rub the stain until the substance becomes brittle. Use a clean, dull, flat knife to gently remove the substance.

Bleach Cleanable

Before bleach-cleaning, make sure fabric is dry and has been vacuumed. Prepare bleach solution (4 parts water to 1 part bleach). Apply cleaning solution using a misting spray bottle. Work the solution into the affected area by lightly scrubbing the area with a sponge or soft bristle brush. Make sure to work from the outside of the stain inward so as not to spread the stain and rinse your sponge or brush frequently. Rinse thoroughly to remove all bleach residues from the fabric. Allow fabric to air dry.
