

## Complete Care and Cleaning Guide



**Product Name:** Ludlow

**Content:** 100% Polyester

**Finish:** Superior Stain Resistance

**Cleaning Code:** W/S

Soap and water, alcohol and bleach resistant.

**General Maintenance:**

Vacuum frequently using the proper attachment to avoid pilling fabric.

### Regular Cleaning

Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or a mild dry cleaning solvent. Do not saturate with liquid. Cushion cover should not be removed and dry cleaned.

### Disinfecting

The most effective method to disinfect for the prevention of virus spread in interior environments is regular cleaning and disinfection. The most commonly used disinfection agent is diluted bleach (10:1) or isopropyl alcohol (70% solution).

### Stain Treatment

Soak up any excess moisture immediately. Before applying cleaners to the soiled area, test a small hidden area first to be sure there are no adverse effects to the color or texture of the fabric.

Use a clean, soft, white cloth to apply water-free dry cleaning solvent or mild water based cleaner. Blot the stain switching to a clean part of the cloth each time. This will avoid reapplying the dirt to the area being cleaned. Avoid excess rubbing to prevent discoloration and damage to the material. Blot with clear clean water. Let dry and then vacuum.

For insoluble stains use a plastic bag filled with ice to rub the stain until the substance becomes brittle. Use a clean, dull, flat knife to gently remove the substance.

**Blot fabric with clean water and a soft white cloth. Residue left by cleaning agents will degrade, shorten the life and affect the products appearance if not removed.**
